Study Go is really good for side effects with children (concentration, arithmetic, etc.). Documents who prove that are important to be able to teach Go to childrens in schools (show parents and teachers). Bring Go to schools, for their special projects for example.
 - Important also to set up one good method to teach Go. Train people to teach Go.
 - Train top go players is one of the main goal for the future.
 - Give a good image of Go.
